

Known Issues in NGRX.2025.01 release

This section lists reported issues that remain unresolved as of the latest release. Wherever a workaround is available, it is noted or referenced in detail. For many of the workarounds in this section, you must have administrative privileges.

| <u>Component</u> | <u>Issue</u> | <u>Description</u> |

| NGRX Advanced Search | ARCHER-164893 | The page crashes when opening a hierarchical node in the drill-down table. As a workaround, perform the first search with Flat visualization, then switch to Hierarchical in the Drill-down options tab. |
| NGRX Advanced Search | ARCHER-164943 | As a temporary solution, you can click on the "Drilldown options" tab and return to "Visualisation" to achieve the same result. In the meantime, our team is actively working on fix. |
| NGRX Advanced Search | ARCHER-165564 | The Advanced Search configuration panel fails to display default fields when a relationship is added to the current application and then switched to another via the Navigation menu. Reloading the page should restore the default fields. |
| NGRX Advanced Search | ARCHER-165572 | The results do not accurately reflect changes in the drill-down field selection criteria for hierarchical charts. |
| NGRX Record Page | ARCHER-160057 | Users can't save records if off-layout field validation triggers. However, error messages are not displayed on the record page. |
| NGRX Record Page | ARCHER-162361 | The record page does not populate the Related Record field on the record page when an internal cross- reference is added. |
| NGRX Record Page | ARCHER-164334 | The CR grid displays the label text of another cross-reference field (within the grid) when that cross-reference field has the Advanced Display option enabled. |
| NGRX Record Page | ARCHER-164726 | The calculated cross-reference field does not display an error message when the maximum allowed cross-reference record validation fails. |
| NGRX Record Page | ARCHER-165172 | Unable to save a newly created parent record when a new cross-referenced record is added to it. |
| NGRX Record Page | ARCHER-165190 | The DDE Apply conditional layout action is incorrectly applied to unrelated users/groups for new records. |
| NGRX Record Page | ARCHER-165192 | The DDE Rule evaluation fails when the rule criteria are based on an off-layout field with a default value. |
| NGRX Record Page | ARCHER-165379 | Records at the Section level of the Authoritative Sources application display save and cancel buttons even when no changes have been made by the user. |
| NGRX Record Page | ARCHER-165473 | When a DDE Rule hides a section, and another rule subsequently makes that section visible, the fields within that section do not appear. |
| NGRX Record Page | ARCHER-165707 | Details of auto-generated findings are not visible on the Record page for the US, EMEA, APJ, UAE, and Canada regions. |

| NGRX Advanced Search | ARCHER-161202 | CR/RR look-up window does not show results in the default sort order. |
| NGRX Advanced Search | ARCHER-162533 | When users drill down into a treemap report, the drill-down charts do not accurately display the drill-down information. |
| NGRX Record Page | ARCHER-162700 | If you change the number of records per page, the keyword search in a Cross-Reference record lookup window does not return the correct result. |
| NGRX Record Page | ARCHER-163706 | When the DDE sets a user group field to Read-Only on a new Record, the selected user is not displayed until the record is saved. |
| NGRX Record Page | ARCHER-163882 | When a tab set contains multiple tabs, some tabs become hidden after users navigate away to other tabs. The hidden tabs do not reappear until the record page is refreshed. |
| NGRX Record Page | ARCHER-164169 | Selecting a different application record via the left menu does not refresh the breadcrumb; instead, it continues to display the breadcrumb from the previously selected application. |
| NGRX-Record | CE-121809 | The cross-reference field with a filter and sorting option enabled by grouping does not display the correct result. |
| NGRX-Record | CE-121818 | A field with long names wraps the text, causing it to overlap with the value |
| NGRX-Record | CE-121844 | Questionnaires in the new experience display questions that should be hidden. |
| NGRX-Record | CE-121913 | The read-only subform field displays edit control to edit the subform records. |
| NGRX-Record | CE-121960 | Unlike the classic experience, the new interface supports alpha values for color properties, making the values in the list appear lighter. |
| NGRX-Record | CE-121961 | The 'Copy link' acknowledgment message contains untranslated strings. |
